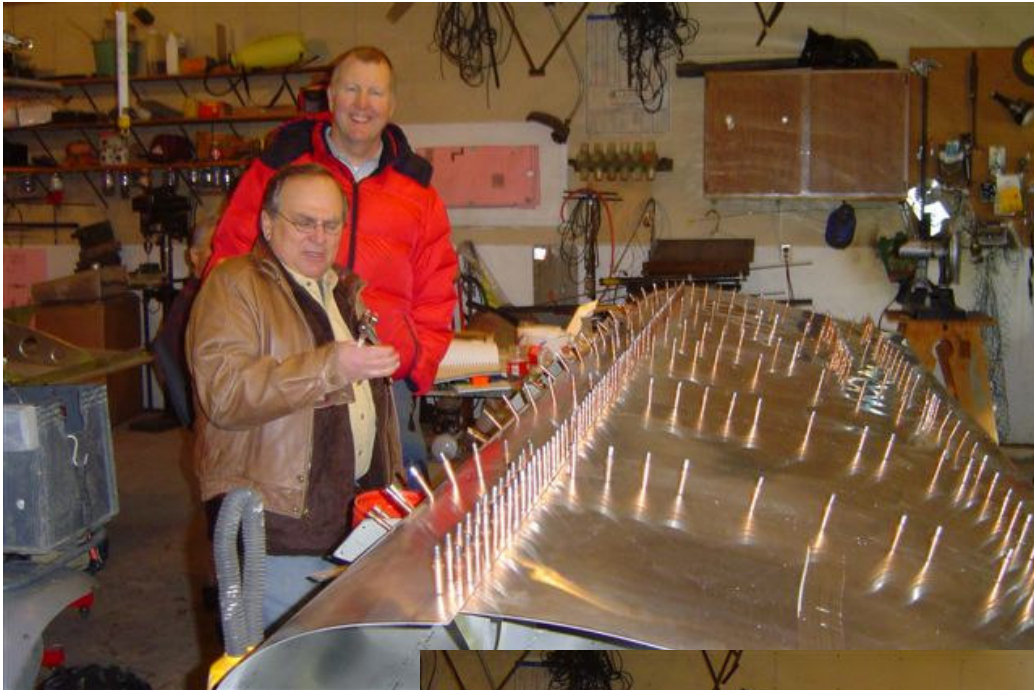

From the Left Seat...

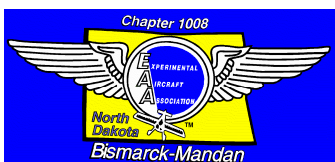

Freddy Wooten and I left BIS and flew to HZE, we made a hands off GPS approach to RWY14 down to decision height with a touch & go. The system then automatically flew us to the missed approach fix. We then set in a flight plan back to BIS via Washburn and flew an ILS RWY13 approach to DH and landed. I wish I could fly a manual ILS as consistent as the G1000. That system locked onto the ILS and didn't waiver all the way down. If you have not experienced that feeling and would like to, come and join us in the CAP and see for yourself.
